The Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) will provide consultative ABA services to adults with Intellectual or Developmental Disabilities, Autism, and/or Mental Illness dual diagnoses in home and community-based settings. Responsibilities include Functional Behavior Assessments of interfering behavior, development of written Behavior Support Plans when necessary, and training caregivers to implement treatment. The BCBA will provide ongoing monitoring of implementation and participation in team meetings on behalf of each client as needed. In addition, data collection, analysis, and development of data-based treatment summary reports are required to share treatment progress with clinical support teams to best determine if progress is being made. The BCBA will use advanced clinical skills to interact with all team members in a professional and supportive manner, collaborating effectively with professionals from other service areas, clients, family members, and other team and community members.

Berth Behavior Consultation is a small group data-driven practice established in Wilmington, NC in 2015, serving clients in the surrounding southeastern North Carolina area. Clinicians will have flexibility in their schedule to best meet their personal needs and the needs of individuals and clinical teams we serve. Commission is based on billable hours (no minimum or cap) with the opportunity to earn quarterly bonuses. The caseload is small and manageable, and supervision, training, and mentorship are provided.
